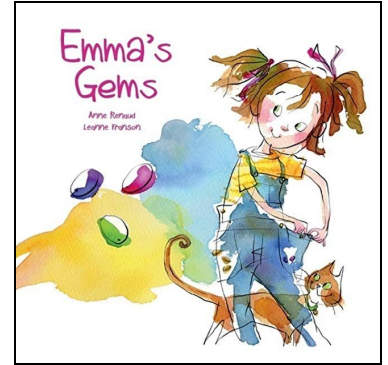


Emma's Gems
