detective, public speaker, and a critically-acclaimed author whose 2015 book, That Lonely Section of Hell, was selected as one of the Globe and Mail's best books of the year. His 2019 memoir, This One Looks Like a Boy, was called "a pointed object lesson into why transauthored work about transgender experiences remains critical" by Quill & Quire and was named one of the best nonfiction books of 2019 by CBC Books.
