Task: Create a poster for your school or home that shows The Life Cycle of a Frog **or** An Ephemeral Pond.

Frog Poster

- $\hfill\square$ Teach someone about the life cycle of the frog
- $\hfill\square$ Make sure that you use a circle to indicate a cycle
- □ Use the Title: Life Cycle of A Frog
- □ Label your diagrams at each stage (subheadings)
- \square Make it big enough so that people can see it
- $\hfill\square$ Use interesting materials to illustrate your poster
- $\hfill\square$ Add any interesting facts you learned from the book
- Make sure you add that your information came the book, Tadpoles by Matt James

Ephemeral Pond Poster

- Teach someone what an Ephemeral Pond is (add a definition to your poster) and what creatures call it their habitat
- □ Use animals like Fairy Shrimp, Spotted Salamander, Twelve-Spotted Dragonfly, Spotted Turtle
- $\hfill\square$ research a few facts about each species to put on your poster
- \Box Use the Title: An Ephemeral Pond
- □ Label your diagrams (subheadings)
- \Box Make it big enough so that people can see it
- $\hfill\square$ Use interesting materials to illustrate your poster
- $\hfill\square$ Add any interesting facts you learned from the book
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
