- 4. How does **journaling** help one express/process one's emotions?
- 5. Explore how the image of a **butterfly** represents the protagonist Baylee?
- 6. The author M-E Girard dedicated this novel to "...all the girls, but most especially the girls like me and the ones like Miss Beckie." Who do you think the girls "like me" are? Who do you think the girls like Miss Beckie are?
- 7. What is self love?
