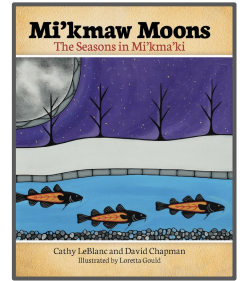




Before Reading
