






The Blue Spruce Award $^{\text{TM}}$


















The Silver Birch Express Award®

ages 8-10, Grades 3-4 | English, fiction / non-fiction




























The Silver Birch Fiction Award®



























The Yellow Cedar Award


ages 9-14, Grades 4-8 | English, non-fiction
































The Red Maple Award $^{\text{TM}}$

ages 12-14, Grades 7-8 | English, fiction




























The White Pine AwardTM























Getting involved in the Forest of Reading is as easy as 1, 2, 3...4.
