


“The Dark Won’t Wait” by David A. Poulsen

4. Dom and Mia feel helpless to support Farhad at moments in the novel. Why do you think it is so difficult for them to know what to say and how to act around of their friend? What do they learn about being “white saviors” and unintentional racism through their experiences?
5. There are many moments from the play that are echoed throughout the novel. List three examples of Dom’s reality reflecting his experience in the play.
6. At the end of the novel, David A. Poulsen shares an author interview. What questions would you ask the author about “The Dark Won’t Wait” or about his writing experience?
