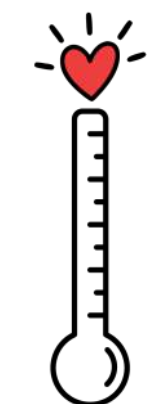
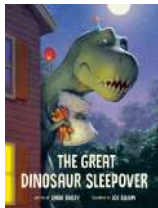
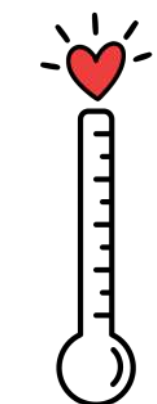
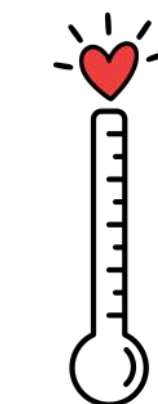
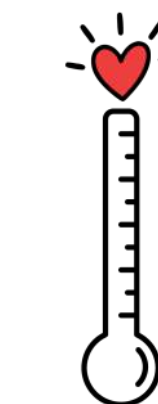
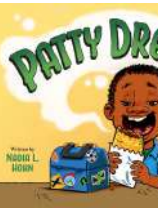
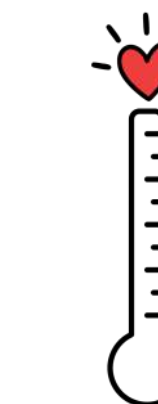
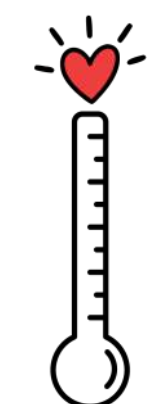
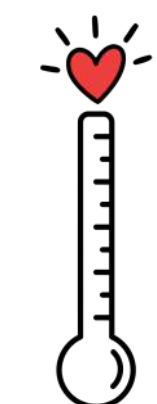
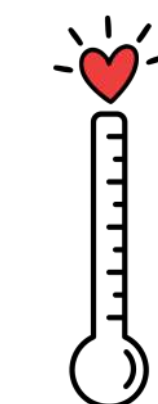
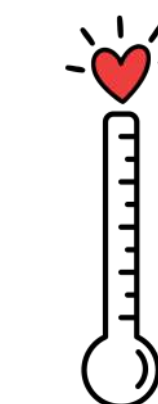
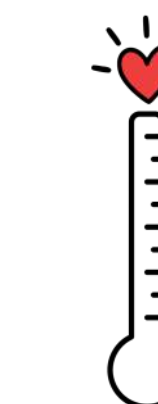
Thinking About Our Hearts and Stories

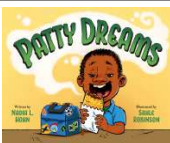
